**Friday, November 14, 2025**

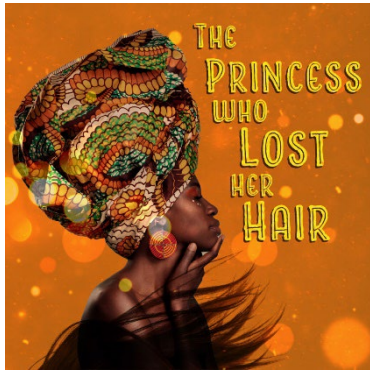
